








Religion: Judaism	Enquiry Question: How special is the relationship Jewish people have with God?	Year Group: 4 Autumn 1
In this enquiry, we will look at how Jewish people commemorate key people and key stories. They reflect on how these stories are relevant in our lives today and on the special relationship Jewish people believe they have with God.		

<p>What we will learn:</p> <p>We will learn about the <u>Story of Abraham</u> and the covenant with God. <u>Moses and the Ten Commandments:</u> The Ten Commandments were given to Moses by God:</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 10 commandments helped give the Jews order when on the journey to the 'promised land'. <p><u>The Synagogue</u> The main place for community worship is the synagogue.
