






Progress from KS1 to end of KS2

- **Reading**: Above LA and National (Top 40% National percentile)
- Writing: In line with national and below LA (Middle 50% National average)
- Maths: Above LA and National (Top 25% National percentile)

The graph below shows the % of pupils who met (level 2+) and exceeded (level 3) at the end of KS1 and the % who are working at the expected standard or better at the end of KS2.



This table demonstrates that in all areas more children have reached the expected standard and greater depth despite the bar being raised 2016.

2016 and 2017 results are based on the newer curriculum which places greater expectations on children so cannot be directly compared to previous years as expectation do not correlate. However 2017 results are a marked improvement from last year.
