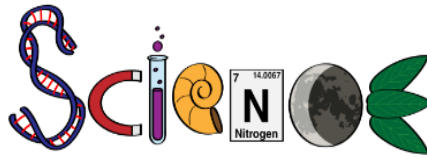

UK-wide poster competition

As a part of celebrating British Science Week, the British Science Association (BSA) is running a poster Competition.

To enter, you simply need to create a poster which fits in with the theme of **'Time'** – what it means to you and how it relates to the science you've learnt about. Here are some points and questions to get you going:

- Think about your own time – how do you spend it? At home, out playing in the park, arts and crafts, learning at school?
- How a certain type of technology has changed over time, or even the advancement of time-telling technology itself.
- What about time in the world, and beyond? How do we measure time – seconds, days, seasons, centuries? What about time in space?
- Are there any scientists you know of whose work relates to time? What about time travel in films, TV and music?
- What might the world look like in years to come, or perhaps look at nature – lifecycles, lifespans, evolution and hibernation – nature is full of timely topics.

Here is the list of **materials you can use**:

Paper (A4 or A3)

Creative materials: pens, pencils, scissors, glue, watercolours, paint, crayons, pipe cleaners, felt, thread, wool, foil, clay, string, beads, stamps, foam, pompoms

Once you've done your thinking, it's time for you to get creative! You can use pop-up pictures, pull out tabs. All work must be original and created by the children – please do not use any templates.





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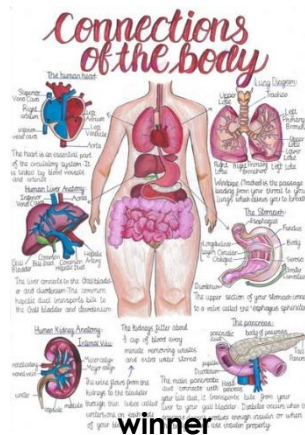
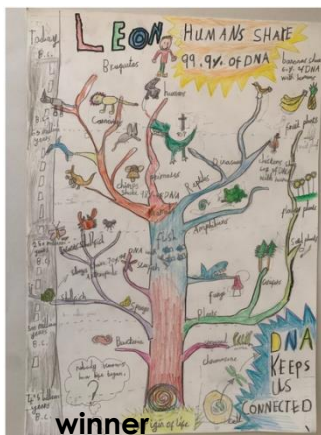
Posters will be judged on the following criteria:

- **Creativity in approach** – Innovative angle on the content or creative interpretation of the theme – don't be afraid to think outside the box
- **Content** – Clear, accurate and informative about a STEM topic
- **Effective communication** – presented and communicated in an engaging way

The five best creations will be chosen at school and will be submitted on the BSA website for a chance of winning an array of prizes.

First names, ages and schools of students may also be shared on BSA website and social media pages – if you do not want this data to be shared online you should make this explicitly clear in your submission, and we will only share the school name.
